Letter to AG's Office and Policy on Students at Risk

In a follow up to the May 4, 2007, meeting of the Student Affairs Committee of the Board of Visitors, Mr. Fraim distributed a copy of Radford University's policy dealing with students exhibiting suicidal tendencies or behavior. The Committee recommended that the Board of Visitors approve this policy.

Also in follow up to the May 4th meeting, the Committee reviewed a draft of a letter to Attorney General, Bob McDonnell, from Board of Visitors Recto, R.J. Kirk. The letter requested that the Attorney General review Radford University's Policy on Students at Risk as to the policy's consistency with the current law. The Committee recommended that the BOV approve the draft of the letter.

Mary Ann Hovis made a recommendation that the Board of Visitors commend the Radford University staff who handle the most difficult situations involving students at risk.
