

PERMISSION FOR OVERLOAD

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS:

A student may not take more than 18 semester hours (7 semester hours for a summer session) without written permission of the student's academic dean. A student on academic probation may not carry more than 16 semester hours (7 semester hours for a summer session) without written permission of the student's academic dean.

GRADUATE STUDENTS:

A student may not take more than 14 semester hours (7 semester hours for a summer session) without written permission of the dean of the College of Graduate and Extended Education. A student on academic probation may not carry more than 9 semester hours (4 semester hours for a summer session) without written permission of the dean of the College of Graduate and Extended Education.
