AP Faculty who have been employed for a minimum of 12 consecutive months as of the motion approval are eligible for paid parental leave. AP faculty should refer to the policy or contact the Human Resources Office for information on eligibility.

Susan Trageser said the goal is to see how the motion can be implemented. Budget and Finance is doing a financial analysis at present. When they get back, Susan will take the financial implications to the Cabinet.
