Dear Dean:

The American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) is pleased to send you the **ANCC Aggregate Data Report(s)** for the Nurse Practitioner and/or Clinical Nurse Specialist program(s), as well as several specialty programs (as applicable) at your institution. Enclosed is a summary of the overall pass rate, by year of graduation. This report provides summary information on the performance of graduates from your program on the ANCC examinations from 1/1/2015 to 12/31/2015.

The ANCC Aggregate Data Report continues to report the results of candidates testing for the first time with ANCC. We are reporting the performance data by the year the candidate graduated. (The maximum scaled score is 500. A passing scale score is 350.) *Please be advised that beginning in 2013, candidates had the opportunity to be made authorized to sit for ANCC certification examinations, prior to degree conferral but after all coursework for the degree was completed. This scenario may appear to skew or alter your aggregate data as the results will reflect statistics for students that have completed the degree requirements but did not receive degree conferral in 2015. To protect candidate confidentiality, if fewer than three candidates took the examination from your program, their performance data is not included.*

This report should be used as only one of the tools to evaluate your program. This is important if the number of candidates tested from your program is small or if you have graduates from prior years testing. Also, ANCC examinations are based on a national role delineation study rather than a specific school curriculum. As an ongoing service to graduate programs, ANCC will continue to provide the aggregate data report to you on an annual basis.
