Math 100 Test #1 Information

<u>How:</u> The test will be delivered online via WebWork, just like your quizzes. Your username is your Radford username (same as the quizzes) and your password is your last six digits of your Radford ID (same as the quizzes). You will see a link to click for "Test 1" link for the test when you log in on Friday, September 4. When: The test will go live and will be accessible for you to take this upcoming Friday, September 4 at 12:01am and will available until 10pm. (You will be able to take the exam any time on Friday, September 4 between 12:01am and 10pm). At 10pm Friday, the test will no longer be available.

<u>To Warm Up:</u> There is an "IntroQuizTest" link available for you now to take a few practice problems so you can see the format and delivery system of your test on Friday. You can attempt the problems as a trial-run of the testing system.

<u>Time limit:</u> Once you begin the test, you will have 90 minutes to complete the test. You will have one attempt at the test. There will be a built-in timer displayed keeping track of your time.

Format: The exam will be all multiple choice and 25 questions. The test will count 20% of your course grade.
