

## **Hotel Information for the 2009 SCL Forum in Greensboro, NC**

I have reserved 20 rooms at this hotel (based upon price and general quality) for Thursday night, March 12 and Friday night, March 13. They have a blend of one-bed and two-bed rooms, all equipped with queen-size beds. They are ALL non-smoking. The price for a one-bed room is \$52.00 and for a two-bed room, \$54.00. (That does not include taxes, I'm sure.) They will hold this block of rooms until February 26.

To get this rate, you must register before February 26 for the number of nights you will need. (I have set the concert times on Friday to enable some composers and performers to travel up on Friday, and not have to spend the "Thursday night before" in a hotel room.

It is located on the western side of Greensboro, about 5 miles from campus (and about a 10 minute commute). They have free internet service, a continental breakfast, local and long distance calls are free, and fresh coffee/tea available all the time.

If you wish to stay there, call the number above and ask for the rooms reserved under "Dr. Greg Carroll for the SCL Forum." That way you will be able to get the cheaper rate.
