Our national philanthropy is breast cancer research and awareness, and the Radford University chapter of ZTA sponsors an annual Walk for Breast Cancer each fall on campus. On October 15th, 2005 from 8am to 11am we will have our fourth annual Walk for Breast Cancer at Patrick D. Cupp Stadium at the Dedmon Center. A portion of the proceeds from the walk will go to the Covington Scholarship Fund.
