- ² The Radford University Psychology program does not require any particular courses in these categories, so any Germanna course that meets the requirement is acceptable.
- ³ These courses count toward the Bachelor of Science component of the Psychology major.
- ⁴ Recommend either PSYC 225 (Theories of Personality) or PSYC 216 (Social Psychology) to fulfill one Psychology Elective requirement. Will Transfer to RU to fulfill Social Cultural Core Psychology Requirement. Completion of other courses listed here will transfer as electives in the RU psychology major.
- ⁵ MATH 245 is recommended as it will fulfill the RU Psychology requirement for STAT 200.

Satisfying the Radford University Core Curriculum (general education) Program

In accordance with the State Policy on Transfer, students who transfer to Radford University from a Virginia Community College will have satisfied Radford University's Core Curriculum **if they have earned an Associate of Science degree from a Virginia Community College**; or the student is able to earn such a degree by successfully completing the remaining requirements before completing a bachelor's degree at Radford University.

Other Notes

In order to receive a Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Radford University, students must complete 120 credit hours. Students must complete at least 45 hours at Radford University, including at least half of the hours in the Psychology major.
