

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION MINOR

The minor in Business Administration consists of 18 semester hours and is open only to students majoring in the B.S. degree in economics or programs outside the College of Business and Economics. The minor in business administration provides an excellent opportunity for students in all fields to develop a basic understanding of the framework in which business operates. Students take an introductory course in the fundamental business areas and must select one other business course to fulfill the minor requirements.
