

FINANCE MINOR

The minor in Finance consists of 18 semester hours and is open to individuals who are non-finance majors. It is designed to provide students with a solid foundation in financial decision making by exposing them to core topics, principles, and issues related to financial decision making, with the flexibility to tailor the student's focus on areas of particular interest.

Any one (1) course with a FINC prefix plus BLAW 304	6

Note: Students pursuing a Finance minor must earn a GPA of at least 2.0 in the course comprising the minor and declaration of minor should be officially declared for the minor at least one semester prior to graduation. At least 50% of the minor courses required for the minor must be taken at Radford University.
