Applied Macroeconomics: ECON 307, ECON 309, ECON 311, ECON 340, ECON 350, ECON 443

International Economics: ECON 309, ECON 311, ECON 340, ECON 442, ECON 443

6 additional credit hours can be any additional ECON course listed above or any of the following: ECON 295, ECON 391, ECON 408, ECON 451, ECON 488, ECON 490, ECON 495 or ECON 498

- **BS Requirement:** Six-eight (6-8) semester hours of courses are required in specified areas outside the major, which the department chair must approve.

CORE REQUIREMENTS : See 2016-2017 catalog for approved courses..

DEGREE REQUIREMENT NOTES

- 120 credit hours is the minimum to meet graduation requirements.
- A 2.0 minimum is required in the MAJOR **and** CUMULATIVE gpa to meet graduation requirements.
- **MAJOR GPA** is computed using the following classes: ECONOMICS CORE and the required Major courses.
- **ECONOMICS CORE** = 281, ECON 205 & 206; ECON 305 & 306; ECON 330; STAT 200 & ECON 495.
- At least 45 hours must be taken at Radford University to be eligible for graduation, with 30 of the last 39 hours taken at RU; 50% of the semester hours required for this major must be taken at RU.
