**Applied Macroeconomics:** ECON 307, ECON 309, ECON 311, ECON 340, ECON 350, ECON 443

**International Economics:** ECON 309, ECON 311, ECON 340, ECON 442, ECON 443

**6 additional credit hours can be any additional ECON course listed above or any of the following:** ECON 295, ECON 391, ECON 408, ECON 451, ECON 488, ECON 490, ECON 495 or ECON 498

■ **BS Requirement:** Six-eight (6-8) semester hours of courses are required in specified areas per the Degree Audit outside the College of Business and Economics and cannot be courses used to satisfy core requirements.

**CORE REQUIREMENTS :** See 2018-2019 catalog for approved courses.

### DEGREE REQUIREMENT NOTES

- 120 credit hours is the minimum to meet graduation requirements.
- A 2.25 major GPA is required to avoid B.S ECON Major Probation (see catalog for B.S ECON Major Probation policy).
- A 2.25 minimum is required in the MAJOR **and** a 2.000 CUMULATIVE GPA to meet graduation requirements.
- **MAJOR GPA** is computed using the following classes: ITEC 281, STAT 200, Math 126, and required major courses.
- At least 45 hours must be taken at Radford University to be eligible for graduation.; 50% of the semester hours required for this major must be taken at RU.
