## **Notes**

In accordance with the State Policy on Transfer, students who transfer to Radford University from a Virginia Community College will have satisfied Radford University's REAL General Education Curriculum if: (1) <u>they have earned a transferrable</u> <u>Associate's degree</u>; (2) they are able to earn such a degree by successfully completing the Virginia Community College courses remaining for the degree concurrently with the first semester of enrollment at Radford University; or (3) they will earn the associate's degree as a result of credit earned during the first semester of enrollment at Radford University, up to a maximum of 10 hours.

Students must complete at least 120 credit hours to earn a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree; of these 30 hours must be completed at Radford University, including at least half of the hours in the major. Students pursuing a BBA must earn a major GPA 2.250 in order to graduate (the major GPA is defined as all courses in the BBA core and all courses prescribed for the major). Additional Information is available in the Radford University Undergraduate Catalog. Additional Information about transferring to Radford University is available from the Office of Admissions. For any course to count for transfer, it must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.

Course requirements, names and numbering are subject to annual review to ensure compliance with any changes at either institution.
