

ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES: YOUR PATH TO THE EARLY ASSURANCE D.P.T.

What are the benefits of studying Allied Health Sciences as part of the D.P.T. Early Assurance program?

- You'll complete a minimum of 90 hours observational work as an Allied Health Science major — that's more than double the hours required for the Early Assurance program.
- Our curriculum aligns with the Early Assurance program required schedule of six prerequisite courses by end of junior year.
- You will meet others with shared interests and goals through the Radford Undergraduate Physical Therapy Club (including a faculty advisor based in the Department of Health and Human Performance).
- You will participate in a minimum of three hands-on practical field experiences to help define your career goals.
- You will get access to research opportunities often limited to graduate students elsewhere.

Through the Early Assurance program, selected incoming students ensure a guaranteed spot in the Doctor of Physical Therapy program upon completion of their bachelor's degrees without the need for GRE tests, PTCAS applications or a pre-D.P.T. graduate interview.

Incoming students who meet two of the three following criteria are invited to apply to the D.P.T. Early Assurance program: 3.7 weighed GPA; combined 1100 SAT (or 24 ACT) score; a B or higher in at least one AP, IB or Dual Enrollment course.
