

### 2014-15 SFC Budget Allocation

The Student Finance Committee SFC oversees all allocations and expenditures of student activity funds. The committee enforces the policies and procedures approved by the Student Affairs Executive Council and the Vice President of Student Affairs. The groups listed in this document can apply for an annual budget to fully or partially fund their operational and programming needs. The 2014-15 student activity fee approved by the Board of Visitors is \$62.00 per semester for full time students and \$5.20 per credit hour for part time students.
