

CHECKLIST FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Deadlines for application

- Summer sessions: February 1
- Fall semester: June 1
- Spring Semester: October 1

Students are strongly encouraged to have all supporting documents sent by the deadlines. We process the applications on a rolling basis, (meaning the earlier a student applies, the sooner the student will receive an admissions decision). Students can expect a decision four to six weeks after their application and all supporting documents are submitted.

Please note: While original documentation is preferred, photocopied or faxed documents are accepted if they bear original stamps, seals, and/or signatures.

English Proficiency Information

_____ Official TOEFL or IELTS Test Scores

Minimum score requirements for admission:

- A. Paper-based TOEFL: 520 or higher
- B. Computer-based TOEFL: 190 or higher

- C. Internet-based TOEFL: 68 or higher
- D. IELTS 5.5 or higher

_____ Official SAT/ACT (Minimum 440 Critical Reading or 18 English score respectively)

*TOEFL or SAT results should be sent directly to Radford University (code 5565) from: Education Testing Service, Princeton, NJ, 80541. Additional TOEFL information is available through US embassies and consulates.

_____ Students who have completed the GCE “O” or GCSE

*result in English must be equivalent to “A”, “B”, or “C” to be exempt from the TOEFL

_____ Official Bank Statement dated no more than 12 months prior to the term of entry **which discloses the specific amount of money** in U.S. dollars immediately available for your first year of studies. A minimum of \$36,603.00

_____ Letter of Support form from your financial sponsor (multiple sponsors are accepted) **OR** Confidential Statement of Financial Support

_____ Copy of VISA (If you currently have a US visa)
