The prescribed CRJU classes for this minor will require students to describe behaviors, beliefs, and cultures. They will focus on the descriptions of rural culture in the United States, and its accompanying behaviors and beliefs, particularly in the CRJU 380 class. The program will culminate in the final paper assignment for the program's final class, CRJU 384, in which students will describe wildlife crime issues in an international setting that requires the students to describe the behaviors and beliefs of people in countries outside of the United States.

Learning Outcome 2: Students analyze the interactions of behaviors, beliefs, cultures, social institutions, and/or environments.

Students will be assessed in the final paper assignment of this program's final course, CRJU 384, based on their ability to analyze how citizens in countries outside of the United States engage in

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	behaviors that are often illegal, and how those behaviors are the result of the beliefs that their cultures have indoctrinated into them which justify the crimes in their beliefs.
