Description of learning outcome assessment plan: Students' competence to describe behaviors, beliefs, cultures, social institutions, and/or environments will be measured in WGST 200 (Introduction to Women's and Gender Studies) by a final essay. The comprehensive final essay has three topics. "Topic 1" asks students to "describe two major issues that women face in the U.S. and internationally. These issues can be based in behaviors, beliefs, cultures, social institutions or environments. For each issue, use two examples, one from the U.S. and one from another country. Discuss how each issue affects the lives of women in this country and at least one other country in similar and dissimilar ways. For each example you must provide specific evidence drawn from the course materials. You may use any of the readings student presentations, or videos." A rubric to evaluate Outcome 1 has been included with the REAL documents submitted. The second program measure is from the senior portfolio, evaluated by faculty using a rubric. Senior Women's and Gender Studies Minors enroll in WGST 400, a seminar class. Student portfolios are evaluated by faculty using a rubric that includes assessment of Learning Outcome 1. The instructions for this aspect of the portfolio read as follows: Describe one major contemporary issue that affects the lives of women globally. You might consider, for example, the global

Students' abilities to analyze the interactions of behaviors, beliefs, cultures, social institutions, and/or environments will be measured in WGST 200 (Introduction to Women's and Gender Studies) by the final essay. The comprehensive final essay has three topics. "Topic 2" asks students to "discuss how the perspective you developed in Women's Studies has shaped the way you <i>analyze</i> issues that affect women's lives globally. You may consider behaviors, beliefs, cultures, social institutions, and/or environments as these interact with women's lives. Your analysis should explore how TWO cultural differences (e.g, race, ethnicity, class, region, nation, age, sexual orientation, physical ability or global location) affect women's experiences and shape their lives. Faculty will evaluate elements of that goal using a rubric submitted with the REAL documents.
