

FAFSA CHANGES ARE COMING

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA, has been redesigned to be easier for students and their families. It will be available in December 2023.

What's New?

The new FAFSA is shorter — just 46 questions! And you can now list up to 20 colleges on your FAFSA.

Parents, spouses and other family members are now called contributors. Contributors are required to provide consent for the FAFSA to retrieve their tax information directly from the IRS.

Dependent students can now use the "Who is My Parent Wizard" as part of the FAFSA application to determine which parent is required to provide information.

If you have an unusual circumstance, you can now submit the FAFSA under a provisional independent status. The Financial Aid Office will review your information to make a final determination on your eligibility to be considered an independent student.
