The AANPCP Aggregate Score Report contains the overall information of every student who has tested with our organization for the previous year. The report is provided to NP program administrators as a measure of their graduates' achievement; however, information will only be available to individual programs when 3 or more students have taken the respective certification examination during the designated reporting period. Each examination contains 135 questions, broken down into 4 testing domains (assessment, diagnosis, planning, and evaluation). The Program Average represents the averaged score for all tests (initial, re-take, and recertification by exam) taken by the program graduates. It can be seen next to the National Average for comparison. Out of a total testing score of 800, the minimum score of 500 is needed to pass.
