Minutes of the September 21, 2015 Meeting

Representatives of the Presidential Search Committee appointed by the Board of Visitors of Radford University met on Monday, September 21, 2015 with Radford University students in Bondurant Auditorium. The meeting was called to order at 4:15 p.m.

Mr. Wray, Chair of the search committee, welcomed the group and introduced the vice chair, Mary Campbell and the search firm consultants. Mr. Wray asked any members of the search committee present in the audience to stand and be recognized. Mr. Wray followed with an overview of the committee composition and committee charge from the Board of Visitors. Dr. Jan Greenwood followed with an overview of the process and an explanation of the confidential nature of the search and the reasons for a confidential search.

- c. What are your "Points of Pride" for Radford University?
